## **Veteran Build Program**

### **What is the Veteran Build Program?**

Fayetteville Area Habitat for Humanity (FAHFH) provides assistance to military veterans in need of new housing or home repairs.

### **Who is eligible for this program?**

This program is open to all military veterans, provided they have received an honorable or general discharge, and is not restricted to any specific veteran groups. While the primary focus of the program is on critical home repairs for veterans, we also offer assistance with handicap accessibility requirements on a case by case basis.

### **What is critical home repair?**

Critical home repair is interior or exterior work performed to alleviate critical health, life and safety issues or code violations, including a change to or repair of materials or components; a reconfiguration of space; a modification for accessibility; installation or extension of plumbing, mechanical or electrical systems on an existing structure.

### **What are the program requirements?**

- Board-approved family selection criteria apply (need, willingness to partner, ability to repay).
- The home must be owned, not rented.
- A veteran must reside in the home, though the veteran need not own the home, but it must be his/her primary residence.
- Must be current on property taxes.
- Must be unable to afford necessary home improvements and unable to complete them otherwise due to age, disability, or circumstance.
- Must pay the program fee, in full, to Fayetteville area Habitat for Humanity, in accordance with the requested repairs for your house.

### **How do I apply for assistance for myself or my family?**

#### **Required documents:**

- DD214
- Copy of Identification
- FEMA letter or insurance claim (for Hurricane Matthew or Florence)
- Proof of income
- Proof of homeownership—Deed or Mortgage Statement
- Proof of homeowner insurance coverage
